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Introduction SmartTyping

A tremendous timesaver in the medical world, And for anybody who uses an electronic record.

With information technology playing an increasingly prominent role in healthcare, proficiency in typing is becoming ever more critical. Nevertheless, only 30 to 50% of the population can touch-type using all ten fingers.

Up to 25% of the time can be saved by staff and professionals learning to type accurately with ten fingers, rather than the more common 2 to 4 fingers.



Of course, conventional typing courses are available, but these require 4 to 6 months of regular, intensive, and often inconvenient time commitments. Traditional typing courses require tremendous effort and motivation to be effective.

Regardless of your role in the healthcare industry, regulation, and the duty to maintain accurate records are placing increasing strains on the time available for record-keeping.

Health professionals, staff, members of healthcare teams, dental staff and professionals, and others who work in health, technology, management, nursing, pharmacy, or other public health environments, must all comply with the increasing demands upon information for both regulatory and commercial purposes. An average savings of 15% of their time, as proved in the Netherlands, can have a tremendous positive impact on productivity, focus, time management, morale, and, of course, results.



However, to get these results, you have to touch type using 10 fingers blindly in a highly effective manner.

Here's how it works

First, you do a baseline measurement Secondly, you do the one-time 4-hour online training course.

In an imaginative, fun, and creative environment, participants learn over a 4-hour course on how to touch type using ten fingers. Both the left and right hemispheres of the brain are stimulated through visual, kinaesthetic, and auditory learning techniques. Using pictures, music, colors, and physical exercises, the creative and visual fields of the right-brain hemisphere are stimulated simultaneously with some regions of the left-brain hemisphere, with its function for logical, analytical, and abstract thinking.

The benefit of this learning method is increased use of the entire brain, which results in knowledge is far more efficiently stored in long-term memory, and new skills being more effectively accessed. We also spend time on the correct position of the fingers and body posture.

After that, the remaining requirement is only 15 minutes per day for 3 weeks to upgrade skills, speed, and accuracy.

A Unique Online Exercise and Follow-up System.

Before the start of the course, participants receive an email asking them to perform a small typing exercise, measuring their typing skills for speed and accuracy. This establishes their baseline measurement. After the course, they are asked daily by email for the next 15 days, to practice their new typing skills for a maximum of 15 minutes using our online system. Immediately after participants have completed their daily exercise, they receive feedback on speed, accuracy, and time.

Besides the exercises requested by email, participants are welcome to improve their typing skills by practicing using our online exercise environment: SmartTesting and, if necessary, additional online coaching by their trainer or by telephone/skype.

After 15 days of exercises, participants start using SmartTyping in their daily work. Experience demonstrates that speed and accuracy will further improve after this initial period. After completion of the course, participants perform a follow-up evaluation, which shows, on average, a 15 to 20% increase to their baseline measurement!

After the 6-week evaluation exercise, participants are granted an official SmartTyping certificate. Further evaluations are performed at 3 months and 6 months following the course.

Doctors on a typing course

Medical specialists and nurses are taking classes in touch-typing in large numbers.

The introduction of the Electronic Patient Dossier (EPD) in The Netherlands created a run on touch-type courses by medical specialists and nurses. This choice is often twofold. Firstly, specialists want to use the EPD system efficiently. Secondly, touchtyping contributes to patient satisfaction ... Specialists who can touch-type can fully focus their attention on their patient, rather than the keyboard.

"Being able to touch-type is a must because of the introduction of the Electronic Patient Dossier in hospitals. I dreaded it. This activates both the logical, analytical and abstract thinking ability of the left brain hemisphere, and the visual and creative ability of the right brain hemisphere. Participants will experience a great learning acceleration with immediate storage in the long-term memory. After 6 weeks the participants type on average 20% faster than before, but then blind and using 10 fingers. They are rewarded with an official SmartTyping certificate."

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Van der Velde continues: "At first the training was meant for participants from the business environment. However, the training took a different turn thanks to the introduction of the Electronic Patient Dossier in health care. We had to train new trainers quickly to be able to meet the demand for learning how to touch-type. Meanwhile we have already trained many hundreds of specialists in various hospitals and health care organisations."
